Esther is a cranky, paralysed Jewish elderly who requires constant nursing, while Selima is her young Muslim nurse. When Esther's ill treatments lead her housekeeper to quit, Selima brings her mother, Halima, to replace her. Against all odds, the senior Muslim lady and her Jewish employer hit it off so well that Halima agrees to look after Esther full-time. This experience tests their mutual prejudices, before their relationship transforms into an unlikely friendship.

When Esther's son is to leave town for a month, she agrees to stay with Halima for a while. This arrangement incites talks from disapproving neighbours who say that for Halima to earn a living from a Jew is harm. How will this affect their relationship?

Christin, a private detective from his company, to discover the reasons why this lovely woman is still single. Without the slightest scruple, Roland puts the most modern of surveillance methods into operation. Lucas better beware if Elsa finds out.

### TO KILL A MOCKINGBIRD

The film's young protagonists, Scout (Mary Badham) and her brother Jem (Phillip Alford), live in the fictional town of Maycomb, Alabama, during the 1930s. The story covers three years, during which Scout and Jem undergo changes in their lives. They begin as innocent children, who spend their days happily playing games with each other and spying on the town bogeyman, Boo Radley (Robert Duvall). Through their father's (Gregory Peck) work as a lawyer, they begin to learn of the racism and evil prevalent in their town, and mature painfully as they are exposed to it. The kids follow Atticus to watch the trial, in which Tom Robinson is found guilty. Atticus arrives home to find out that Robinson has been killed in attempt to escape. By October 31st things have settled down and Scout goes to a Halloween pageant. On their way home, Scout and Jem are attacked by Bob Ewell. During the struggle, Jem is knocked unconscious and carried away by a mysterious man later revealed as Arthur "Boo" Radley.
